

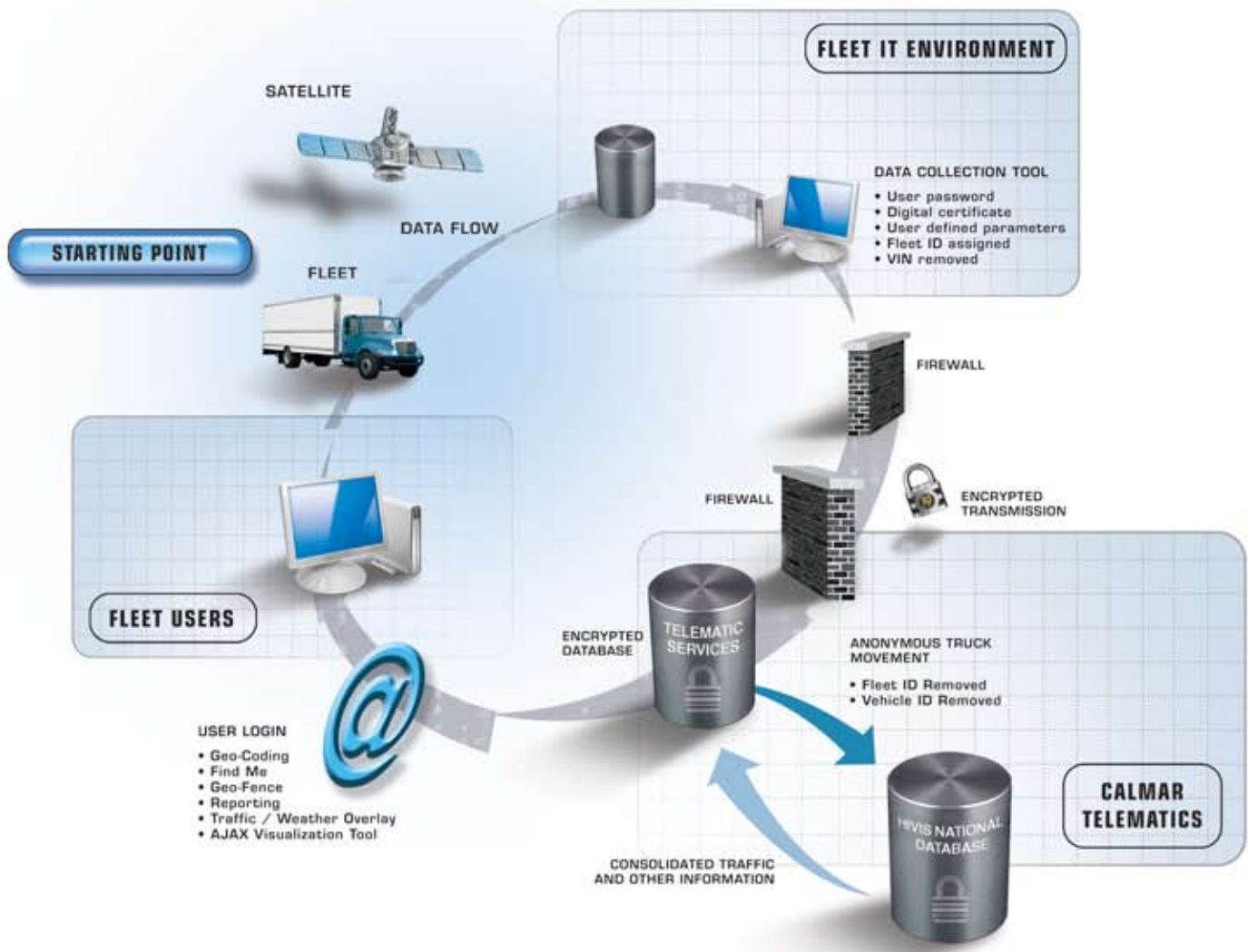

HIVIS is a partnership between government and the trucking industry to reduce congestion and improve highway safety while providing state-of-the-art fleet management tools. HIVIS is powered by Calmar Telematics in partnership with the Federal Highway Administration, NYSDOT, and the NY State Thruway Authority. As detailed below, all fleet information is collected anonymously to be aggregated in the National Highway Database.

FAQ FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who else is contributing to this project?

Besides numerous fleets nationwide, four government agencies will contribute their expertise:

- o The Federal Highway Administration
- o The New York State Energy Research and Development Authority
- o The New York State Department of Transportation
- o The New York State Thruway Authority

What should be our expectations for participating in this project?

In the next year the national database is going to grow exponentially. This means that your company is going to be able to benefit from all the reports and studies that the State and Federal DOT are going to be able to produce. Congestion, Traffic, Road Conditions, Parking, and Routing are some of the reports that your company is going to be able to receive from the project.

How is the information collected?

Fleets across the country will submit data they're already collecting, simply by installing a simple software application at fleet headquarters. The information is always anonymous, secure and under the control of the fleet manager.

What are you doing with our information?

The only thing that we will do is to collect the information that you would like to share with the program and place it into the national database as anonymous data. Once your data is anonymously entered in the National database, highway professionals will study all the data from the different participating fleets. At any point in time, you could log into the website and look at the information that we are collecting from you.

Does it matter what wireless network we are using to communicate with our fleet?

NO. The solution has been built to combine many different types of data into one enormous set of databases that will enrich the trucking industry.

How are we contributing to the National database trucking system?

AVL information is the most important element for the success of this project. The information will be collected, from your database and anonymously entered into the national database system.

How about our drivers' privacy?

Your drivers' privacy is completely secure, because we never have that information. The participating fleets are not linked with any specific data. Highway specialists will study the anonymous data from the National database without infringing on your privacy.
